Dermaplaning

It's like shaving, sort of. Typically, the treatment involves gliding a special blade—not as sharp as a regular razor's—over the skin's outer layer, says N.Y.C. dermatologist Sejal Shah. This mechanical exfoliation removes dead cells and baby hairs (but not coarser ones that lead to stubble, Dr. Shah notes). The result? A smoother complexion.

You can do it at home. Dermaflash (\$189; sephora.com), a device designed for weekly use, evenly sloughs skin using "edges" and has safeguards to prevent irritation. Talk to your dermatologist, though, before DIY dermaplaning.
